Welcome everyone to our final Newsletter for our 2022-2023 fiscal year. It has been a great year filled with new challenges and opportunities. We have lost some cherished members and supporters and we have added some new Friends to our Membership, which reached 306 this year and raised \$27,725. The members that we have lost can never be replaced and they will live on in the work that we continue to do to help Hospice patients and families.

Our major goal was to raise

\$150,000 for uninsured Hospice patients, and we exceeded that goal! Last calendar year, we paid for 2001 days of Hospice care for uninsured Hospice patients through CHRISTUS VNA Hospice. What a wonderful accomplishment, to support those in our community who need us most in their last days.

Our Poinsettia Ball was transformed into our First Annual Poinsettias and Prosecco Party. Liz Jauer, Laura Humphries and Heather Miller did a great job and we raised \$62, 628 from that event. We will be continuing that tradition again this year with the event happening on November 30th at the San Antonio Country Club (save the date in your calendar!).

Our holiday traditions continued with our Angel Tree, which raised \$1725 and our Holiday Card Drive, which raised \$5310. We have such dedicated members that use us every year to send out their Holiday cards and to remember their loved ones during the holiday season. Lois Armor does a great job of making our Angel Tree look beautiful and we love honoring and remembering loved ones who have passed or who make a difference in our lives.

Our Valentine Day Luncheon at the Country Club started 2023 with a bang. Lois Armor and Betty Ferrell and their auction team put on a great lunch and style show. J. McLaughlin provided the fashions and they hosted a Sip and Shop event the week after the event that raised \$1951 for our cause. Our Valentine Event was a big success and we made \$35,337 through our raffle and auction items. Everyone was excited to bid on over 150 auction items donated
